

New Clear Bag Procedures for CCS Athletic Events

Effective Friday, August 22, 2025

To help keep our athletic events safe and entry lines moving quickly, Cumberland County Schools (CCS) has implemented districtwide clear bag procedures. This applies to all CCS athletic events, including those held at your child's school and at other district locations.

What You Can Bring

Each person may bring one clear bag (no larger than 12" x 15" x 3")

You may also carry:

- One small clutch or wristlet (no larger than 4" x 6" x 1")
- One clear, one-gallon Ziploc bag
- A diaper bag (when accompanying a child)
- A medical bag or medically necessary item (such as an oxygen tank or epinephrine)

Other Items That Are Allowed

These items are allowed as long as any pockets or compartments are left open and empty:

- Coats and jackets
- Blankets
- Soft baby carriers or slings
- Strollers
- Medically required equipment (wheelchairs, walkers, etc.)
